

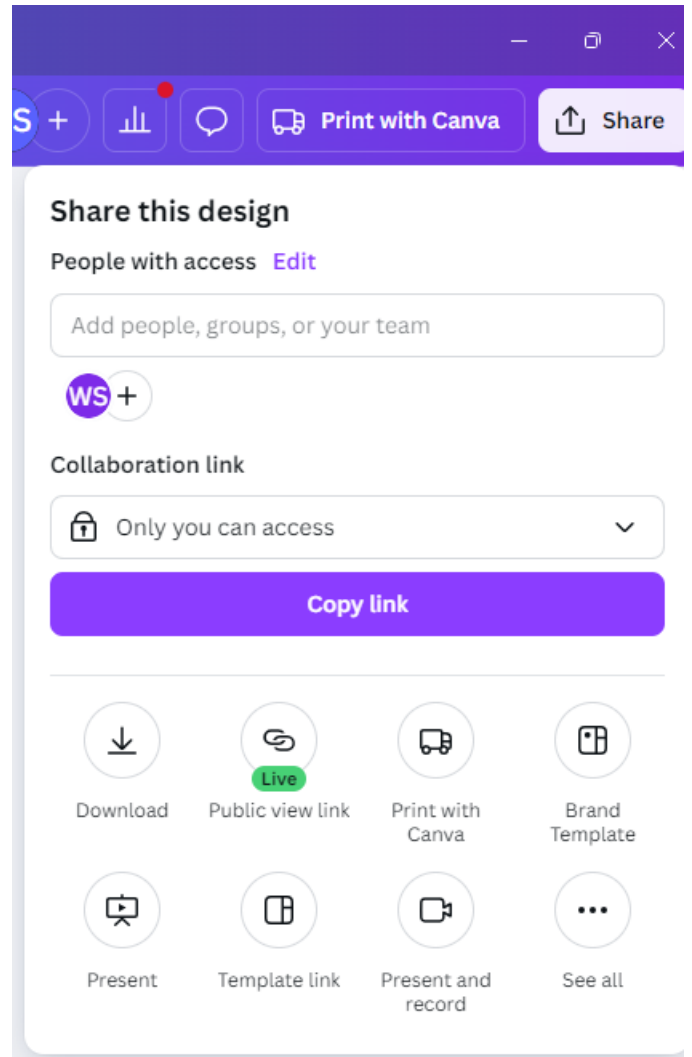
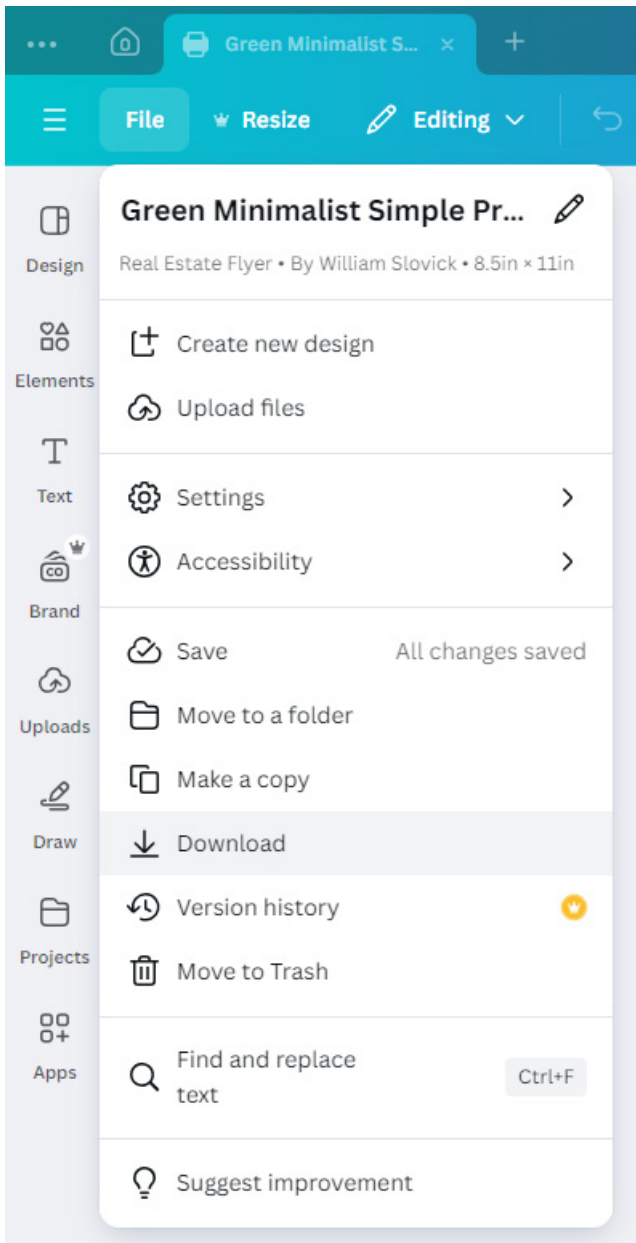
Canva Export Settings

There are two methods to get to the Download settings:


File -> Download

or

Share -> Download.

Please export using PDF Print with crops and bleeds.

Do not flatten! Flattening reduces the editability of the resulting PDFs and can sometimes have unintended consequences in printing.

Use the RGB Color profile. Photos, by default, are RGB. When converted to CMYK, they can lose some vibrancy and depth of color. While converting to CMYK was necessary in the days of ink-based presses, our digital presses can handle the RGB images just fine.
